Discussion regarding a refrigerator for the Youth Commission to use at the Fire Hall during the Summer Camp Program. Supervisor Roder reported that the current one at the Town Hall would be moved to the Fire Hall for the Youth Commission use and Town Clerk Hoffman is going to order a new one for the Town Hall by July $1^{\rm st}$. Library Director Roppolo reported that the Summer Camp programming is in the works and that the library is working on getting the Town listed as an additional insured with the insurance company.

Discussion regarding the mandatory AED requirement from NYS for Summer Youth Programs – Supervisor Roder requested J. Peabody meet with him in regards to the requirements and finding options for purchasing an AED prior to the start of summer camp. J. Peabody reported that she would be able to provide the required training through the Fire Department.

Council Defreest Jr. requested the assistance of the community, the Veteran's are looking to update the monument at the park and looking for veterans in the community that have served during the International War of Terror, only requirement is a copy of their discharge slip with dates for proof. The Veterans' are also seeking help in regards to the flowers and gardens, looking for possibly a gardening club, 4H, possibly the Youth Commission, or anyone that could give us some insight on what is a weed and what's a flower.

Council T. Madden cleaned out the weeds at the Town Park.

Supervisor Roder provided an update on the NYSERDA Clean Energy Grant. The Town has met tier I which allocated \$5,000.00 in grant funds toward an energy audit at the Town Hall. We have met tier II which awards an additional \$10,000.00 in grant funds for energy efficient updates, and the Town was designated a Clean Energy Community which awarded an additional \$5,000.00 in grant funds for energy updates. The Town Board, County and the Fire Department are working on getting 911 signs, the program will be voluntary, people can choose to put a sign up or not, currently looking into funding options.

Council Clark reminds the public that the Town Clean Up Day will be held on Friday, June 7, 2024 from 11:00AM to 7:00PM.
